### These Small Additions Play a Big Role

As you plan the overall design for your space, it's important to factor trims and moldings into the budget. They're a must-have for presenting a cohesive, completed look that functions the way you need it to.

Trims and moldings come in coordinating or matching styles that will blend beautifully with your chosen Robbins SPC flooring product. They hide gaps, joints and edges and create a smooth transition between SPC and other flooring types. All SPC trim pieces are a standard length of 94".

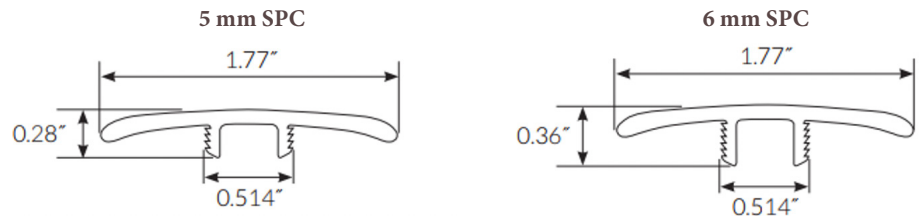


### Understand the Uses for Each Trim & Molding Option

Your project may only require some of these pieces. Here's where and how each is used to complete a SPC flooring installation.

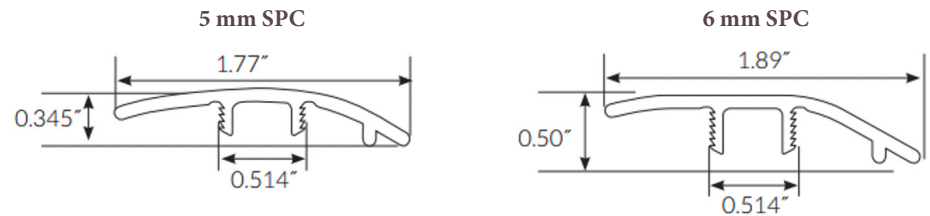
#### T-Molding

- Used between floors of equal height



#### Surface Reducer

- Used between floors of unequal height



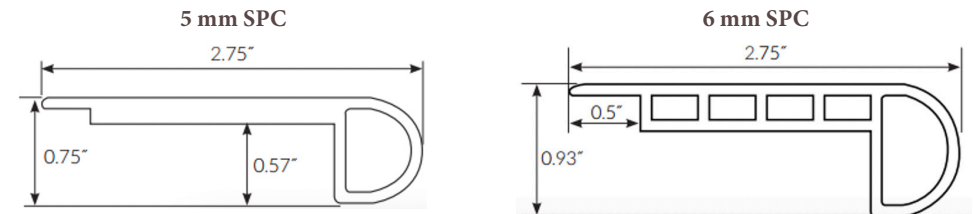
#### End Cap

- Used to fill the gap between the floor and carpet, hearths or against sliding doors



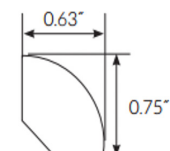
#### Flush Stair Nose

- Finishes the end of a step



#### Quarter Round

- Hides open spaces where the flooring meets steps, baseboards and cabinets
